We are writing this letter concerning the "Conduct of Law Enforcement Agencies" in Bradenton, Starke, and Pensacola, Florida.

As you may or may not know, Taser International (the manufacturer of tasers) is the primary trainer and certifier of law enforcement officers for the use of this weapon. It has come to our attention that over 52 deaths have occurred in Florida as a result of the use of this gun by law enforcers with roughly another 400 more deaths having occurred across America. You may also read on our web site an order issued by the manufacturer that this weapon has been demonstrated to exhibit a lethal capacity. This has just been released 1 week ago, after the SCLC garnered national media attention about the danger of these guns in response to several tragedies in NW Florida.

We are specifically requesting that you review the radio talk show under my heading on our site, starting at the minutes of 21:36. You will notice that the city official stated that they would shoot this gun regardless. They have no remorse concerning the incident occurring in Bradenton, Florida. Also in Bradenton they have issued an ordinance where Africans-American cannot ride their bicycles in the Black communities during the day or at night with certain limitations.

I am also requesting that you review the Steen case in Pensacola, Florida, where a number of marches have taken place concerning the death of this kid, and the case in Starke, Florida where a young lady informed the jailer that she was pregnant and needed medical care but was refused. The next day, while incarcerated, she and her unborn child died due to a lack of medical care.

I need you to really read the numbers of news articles concerning these events and send an investigator to Florida, ASAP. Let's not have our law enforcers recklessly wielding an easily abused weapon due to unwarranted suspicion. You may reach me at the cell # 1-850-450-1982. [www.sclcf.org](http://www.sclcf.org).
